

## **Three Day Tactical Carbine Operator Course**

This course develops a solid foundation of shooting skills with a carbine rifle and allows the student to exercise these skills in a variety of tactical shooting situations. The student will quickly gain experience, confidence and increase his skill level with his service rifle. A beginning shooter can quickly develop the skills of an intermediate shooter and possess the weapons handling skills needed to face most any tactical situation. This course begins with an initial qualification test and ends with a final weapon qualification exam.

### **Skills Taught**

- Weapons assembly/disassembly and maintenance
- Weapons loading/unloading
- Wear of tactical gear and placement
- Fundamentals of Combat Marksmanship (CMMS)
- CMMS principals
- Bore/sight relationship
- Immediate action for malfunctions
- Tactical and Speed reloads
- Trigger manipulation drills
- Recoil management drills
- Slow aimed fire
- Rapid aimed fire
- Single target engagement
- Multiple target engagement
- Shooting and moving
- Use of cover and concealment
- Barricade shooting
- Situational shooting scenarios

- Safety Glasses and hearing protection
- Appropriate weather clothing
- Positive learning attitude
- 1500rds of issued ammunition
